MADISON COUNTY IS UP TO SEVEN CORONAVIRUS CASES

Anderson, IN - Overnight we received three new positive COVID-19 test results in Madison County, IN. With these three additional cases, we are now at seven positive COVID-19 cases. On Thursday evening, the Madison County Health Department announced the county's first death, related to COVID-19. The virus took the life of an older male, Madison County resident who had been hospitalized in a Hamilton County hospital, when he lost his fight against the virus. It is imperative that citizens Stay At Home so we can Slow The Spread of the virus.

Due to HIPAA laws, we will not disclose any information where the patient resides, works, or anything specific to the patient. Regardless of where these seven patients reside, citizens need to follow our standard protocols to Slow the Spread.
