

## Madison County Indiana Schools

<p><b><u>Low or No Spread</u></b> *Less than 12 cases per day over 7-day average</p>	<p>If cases remain at 12 cases per day or less per day, averaged over 7 days, schools are recommended to remain open for in-classroom instruction. Maintain open communication with local and state officials. Adhere to protocol established for sick/ill students and staff. Continue assisting in contact tracing efforts. Practice social distancing and continue CDC recommended hygiene practices to prevent spread. Follow all state and local rules and regulations.</p>
<p><b><u>Moderate Spread</u></b> *13 to 24 cases per day over 7-day average.</p>	<p>If cases increase to between 13 and 24 cases per day averaged over 7 days, consider increasing remote learning opportunities and hybrid model instruction. Enact enhanced social distancing and hygiene practices. Deep clean classrooms and common areas regularly. Continue to participate in contact tracing efforts. Maintain regular communication with health officials. Consider remote instruction for vulnerable populations. Schools may close facilities at their discretion. Follow all state and local rules and regulations.</p>
<p><b><u>Severe Spread</u></b> *Over 24 cases per day over 7-day average.</p>	<p>If cases exceed 24 cases per day over a 7-day average, remote instruction is recommended. Schools should be closed for in classroom instruction until return to moderate or low spread with positive case numbers declining. Maintain open communication with health officials. Participate in contact tracing, when necessary. Deep clean all affected areas and common areas. Follow all state and local rules and regulations.</p>
