MADISON COUNTY REPORTS 2 ADD'L COVID-19 POSITIVE CASES AND 1 DEATH

Anderson, IN - Overnight Madison County added 2 new positive COVID-19 cases and 1 additional death bringing us to 415 positive cases and 47 deaths related to COVID-19.

The current Madison County Public Health Order is set to expire on 4/30/2020 and the current Indiana Public Health Order is set to expire on 5/1/2020. There will be a revised public health order issued by the Governor, that will be in effect thru mid-May. Even though Gov Holcomb has not released the details of a revised Public Health Order, we do NOT anticipate all businesses, including restaurants, salons, bars, tattoo parlors etc being opened fully on May 2. Businesses that are advertising, they will soon reopen is pre-mature. Curb-side business models should remain in place until further notice. During this time, while we are preparing to reopen, businesses should be looking how to adapt to 6' social distancing, masks and personal health /hygiene practices for employees.
